The Garden Doctor's Jobs for the Month – September

- Take cuttings of pelargoniums and osteospermums
- Sow turnips, spinach, winter lettuce, oriental vegetables and onions
- Plant out onion sets and spring cabbage plants
- Cut down asparagus foliage then mulch beds with organic matter
- Prune out diseased shoots on fruit trees
- Pot up hippeastrum bulbs; plant up containers of prepared hyacinths
- Plant evergreen trees and shrubs
- Take semi-ripe cuttings of evergreen shrubs
- Give evergreen hedges a final trim
- Scarify, aerate and top dress lawns; apply autumn lawn food
- Thin out submerged oxygenating plants
- Divide cool-climate grasses and evergreen sedges
- Plant daffodils by mid-September to ensure a good spring show
- Cut out the fruited canes of summer raspberries
- Plant out perennials and divide existing clumps
- Keep camellias and rhododendrons well watered
